- 35 beds in private rooms
- 24/7 coverage by neonatologists
- Quality Oversight Committee, comprised of both John Muir Health and Stanford Children's Health physicians
- Certified by California Children's Services (CCS)
- Neonatal surgery

Who We Treat

- Premature newborns (23+ weeks)
- Term infants, up to 44 weeks corrected gestational age

Complex Neonatal Conditions Treated

- Respiratory failure
 - Mechanical ventilation, high frequency, iNO, CPAP and nasal cannula
- Congenital anomalies requiring surgery
 - Volvulus, bowel atresia, perforation, gastroschisis, omphalocele, CCAM
- Sepsis and shock
- Jaundice, including need for exchange transfusion
- Neurologic conditions, including seizure activity
