

For your patients who require emergency care, John Muir Health is a Level II Trauma Center with orthopedic and trauma surgeons available 24 hours a day, resources in place at all times to treat high-risk and fragile patients, and a multispecialty clinical team, should your patients require non-surgical orthopedic care.



When you refer your patients to John Muir Health, you can rest assured their treatment will involve minimal pain and downtime. In fact, we use the most advanced types of anesthesia, including regional anesthesia, to dramatically reduce post-operative pain.

Advanced orthopedic procedures

Orthopedic surgery techniques have evolved over the years, and John Muir Health continues to incorporate and refine many of the newer, less invasive procedures into our program. Designed to reduce pain and recovery time, these approaches include minimally invasive total joint surgery, leading-edge arthroscopic technology, navigation systems, and new spine decompression and fusion techniques through minimally invasive lateral and posterior approaches.

Our orthopedic surgeons are trained in the most current surgical techniques and treatments. Only the best bearing surfaces are utilized in total joint replacement surgery to maximize joint longevity, with each patient's needs and expectations in mind.

For your patients with spine and/or orthopedic trauma, our surgeons use emerging technologies in fracture fixation and bone grafting to speed healing, decrease recovery time and restore function.

Quality care at every step.

At John Muir Health, we go out of our way to ensure your patients receive a comprehensive continuum of care—from pre-operative services to rehabilitation—that goes well beyond the often isolated components of typical orthopedic services programs. This unique, all-encompassing approach is designed to help your patients return to maximum function as quickly as possible.

Pre-operative care

We offer a variety of services to help prepare your patients for orthopedic surgery, including classes such as pre-operative instruction for patients undergoing hip and knee replacement and spine surgery. We also provide printed patient guides that highlight what to expect before, during and after surgery. Pre-Operative Clinic is available providing pre-surgical assessment for orthopedic patients.

Post-operative care

To help speed recovery, orthopedic-certified registered nurses and nursing assistants, as well as an orthopedic nurse manager, provide around-the-clock care in our dedicated orthopedics unit. We also offer a customized exercise and mobility program designed to safely get patients up and moving in a timely manner.

Discharge

To prepare your patients for a seamless transition from hospital to home or community care, case managers, physicians, nurses, and physical and occupational therapists will assess your patients' progress and make recommendations for optimum recovery. Rehabilitation begins in the hospital after surgery and, if necessary, continues at an outpatient therapy clinic, in the patient's home or in a skilled nursing facility. To ensure you are kept up-to-date, a full discharge summary will be sent to you directly.

Rehabilitation

Our comprehensive rehabilitation services include a 30-bed acute inpatient rehabilitation unit and several outpatient rehabilitation centers offering physical and occupational therapy.

Dedicated to returning your patient to maximum function.

At John Muir Health, our primary goal is to provide your patients with an exceptional experience from pre-op to rehab, and to return them to you with maximum function following surgery. To this end, our highly skilled orthopedic specialists utilize only the most current techniques in pain management. Our surgeons use computer-guided technology as needed for implant placement and replacement, and are trained in both minimally invasive approaches and more traditional surgeries. For your patients who require joint surgery, our specialty-trained surgeons employ state-of-the-art reconstructive techniques.

Designated as a Level II Trauma Center, John Muir Health offers outstanding rapid response care and surgical interventions by leading fellowship-trained trauma surgeons.


Spine care

Our spine specialists offer operative and non-operative management for virtually all types of spinal disorders—from spinal stenosis and degenerative conditions to spinal trauma, infection and tumors.

Both inpatient and outpatient treatments are provided by our physicians.

- Microdiscectomy
- Laminectomy, laminoplasty, foraminotomy
- Motion preservation surgery
- Spine stabilization and fusion surgery
- Minimally Invasive Surgery techniques

- Cancer reconstruction
- Complex spine deformity treatment

Total joint replacement surgery

Our surgeons work with you and your patient to determine which procedure will ensure minimal pain, faster healing and a quicker recovery.

- Minimally invasive, traditional approach and reconstruction/revision procedures for the hip, knee and shoulder
- Anterior hip replacement / hip resurfacing
- State-of-the-art technology and surgical implants

- Patient Specific Instrumentation
- Revision hip and knee replacement, including revision of failed replacements
- Comprehensive management of osteonecrosis
- Management of massive bone loss
- Management of infected joint replacement

Total joint revision surgery

Revision surgery of the hip or knee is the replacement of the old prosthesis with a new prosthesis. Revision may be due to failure of the prosthesis from instability, a broken or dislocated implant or bone infection. Revision surgery is a complex procedure that requires more time than a primary procedure.

Joint Preservation

Joint preservation is a concept of restoring normal and pain-free function to the knee, hip, and shoulder joint. Joint preservation is achieved through the use of multi-modality treatment options that can include activity modifications, physical therapy, medications, injections, and sometimes surgery.

Just as every patient is different, each patient's joint preservation strategy is personalized for his or her age, activity level, expectations, and degree of joint dysfunction. As mechanical causes of degenerative joint disease are now recognized earlier in the disease process, these techniques may be used to decelerate or even prevent progression to osteoarthritis.

Joint-Preserving Techniques:

- Arthroscopy
- Realignment osteotomy (femoral or acetabular)
- Arthrotomy
- Biologic resurfacing of articular surfaces
- Bone reshaping

Anterior hip replacement

Our orthopedic surgeons perform hip replacement surgeries using state-of-the-art minimally invasive techniques such as anterior hip replacement.

- Potential procedure for patients presenting for primary hip replacement
- No muscle releases or significant activity restrictions postoperatively
- The dislocation rates are approximately 0-2 percent
- There is potential for a fast return to function and normal gait

Upper extremity/shoulder/elbow/hand surgery

Our orthopedic surgeons are board-certified and specially trained to provide treatment for our patients with common and complex disorders of the hand and upper extremities. Surgical procedures may include arthroscopy, microsurgery and joint replacement of the hand, elbow, wrist and shoulder, as a result of injury or chronic debilitative conditions.

Foot/ankle surgery



Sports Medicine




Modern facilities designed to speed healing and recovery.
